Maintenance Calendar

Keep your Village Green® looking great all year round by following the recommendations in the checklist below

JANUARY

- Apply 30mm irrigation weekly
- Mow weekly at 10-15mm
- Summer application of wetting agent
- Renovate e.g. coring & topdressing

FEBRUARY

- Apply 30mm irrigation weekly
- Mow weekly at 10-15mm
- Renovate e.g. coring & topdressing

MARCH

- Apply 20mm irrigation weekly
- Mow weekly at 15 – 20mm
- Avoid scalping

To achieve maximum year round quality with Village Green®, test leaf tissue for nitrogen. Apply fertilisers when levels fall below 2.2%.

APRIL

- Apply 10mm irrigation weekly if required
- Apply foliar iron, manganese and nitrogen
- Mow weekly at 15 – 20mm
- Avoid scalping

MAY

- Apply one or two 8mm irrigation events if required
- Apply granular nitrogen fertiliser
- Mow weekly at 15 – 20mm

JUNE

- No irrigation required
- Mow fortnightly at 15 – 20mm
- Apply foliar iron and manganese in high wear situations
- Control broadleaf weeds if required

Best mowing height for Village Green® is between 10 and 20mm. Avoid scalping, especially during autumn/winter.

JULY

- No irrigation required
- Apply granular nitrogen fertiliser
- Mow fortnightly at 15-20mm

AUGUST

- Apply one 8mm irrigation events if required
- Apply foliar iron and manganese in high wear situations
- Mow weekly at 15 – 20mm
- Apply pre-Spring application of wetting agent

SEPTEMBER

- Apply one or two 8mm irrigation events if required
- Apply granular nitrogen fertiliser
- Mow weekly at 15 – 20mm

Under heavy wear and/or shade during cooler months, apply foliar applications of the trace elements iron and manganese.

OCTOBER

- Apply 12mm irrigation per week
- Mow weekly at 10-15mm

NOVEMBER

- Apply 20mm irrigation per week
- Mow weekly at 10-15mm
- Renovate e.g. coring & topdressing

DECEMBER

- Apply 25mm irrigation per week
- Mow weekly at 10-15mm
- Renovate e.g. coring & topdressing
